Principles on Aid Coordination


- Government of Kosova intends to lead the Kosovo's development process
- Establish a partnership with international stakeholders
- Aid should finance Kosovo development priorities
- Kosovo should have a well defined planning process which includes its European integration ambitions
- The delivery management and monitoring of aid should use government systems

Agency for Coordination of Development and European Integration

- Government Decision October 2008 establishing the Agency for Coordination of Development and European Integration
- Merging the Donor Coordination Center and Agency for European Integration
- Harmonizing the Kosovo development agenda and European integration

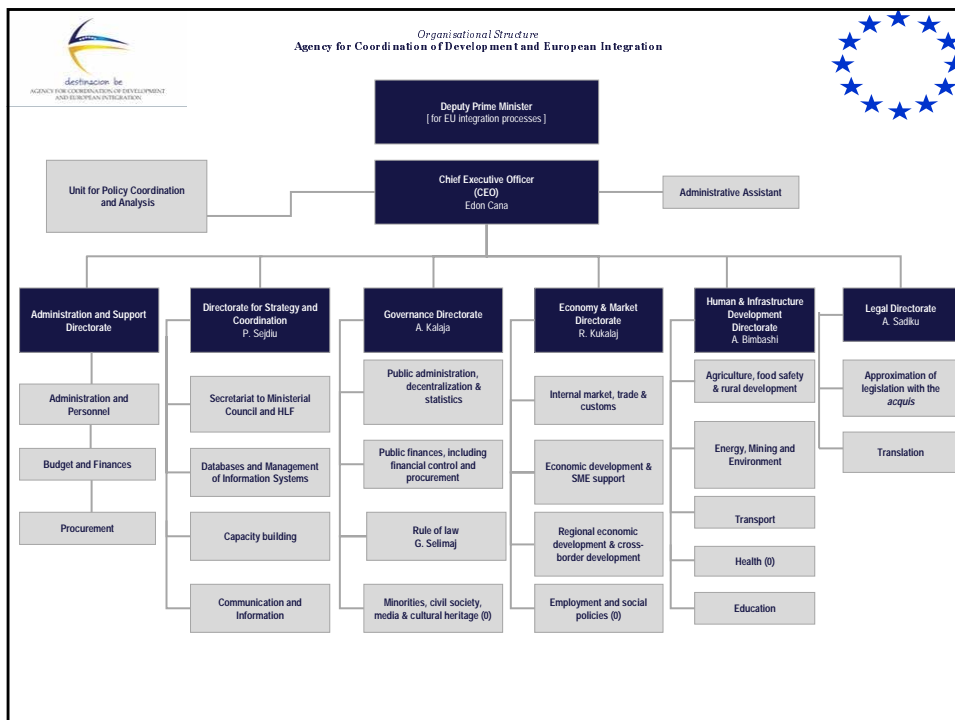
Role of ACDEI

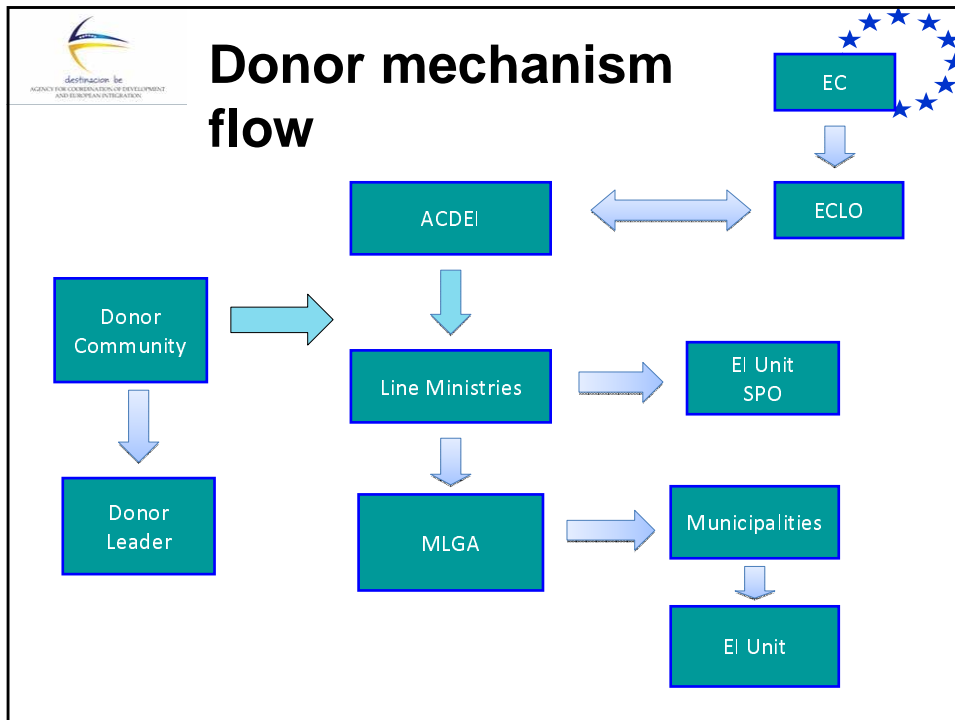
- Coordinate the elaboration and monitor the implementation of the European Partnership Action Plan (EPAP), including ensuring it is on budget (MTEF), as a response to the European Partnership (EP)
- Coordinate Government Activities related to its development priorities, EU approximation and participation in the Stabilisation and Association Process (SAP)
- Responsible for ensuring that donors are fully informed and that overlap with other ongoing or planned activities of other donors or the Governments own funds is avoided as far as possible



Role of ACDEI



- Review, harmonise, align and coordinate sectoral policies in line with the national development and EU integration priorities
- To increase the efficiency of aid by improving its alignment to development priority areas and reducing the overlap of donor assistance
- Participates in programming of (EU and other) donor assistance in coordination with beneficiary institutions and support relevant capacity development





Objectives (1)

- Ensure the alignment of donor assistance to government sector policies;
- Reduce transaction costs for Government, both for managing aid and for defining and agreeing on development policy;
- Allow donors to provide increasingly greater amounts of budget support towards a better balance of on- and off-budget assistance;
- Support policies that provide a more lasting impact for technical assistance programmes;



Objectives (2)

- Monitor progress in aid effectiveness and promote donor coordination in meeting the joint goals of development and European Integration and in aid coordination, including through a High Level Forum (HLF) that would meet at least annually
- Maintain an integrated database containing multi-year information on all existing and planned donor projects and programmes and ensure the production of comprehensive management information systems
- Strengthen the government's own monitoring and evaluation systems
